## Low-Income Subsidy Plans Available to Help with Overall Health

Helping our members live better, healthier lives is always our topmost priority. Keeping that in mind, we wanted to remind you about the **Low-Income Subsidy (LIS) plans** that Wellcare has designed for beneficiaries with limited resources who:

- DO qualify for the Low-Income Subsidy (also known as “Extra Help”), but
- DO NOT qualify for a zero-dollar, dual special needs plan.

While those qualifying for “Extra Help” can choose any plan with Part D, including Part D standalone plans, Wellcare’s LIS plans work specifically with the government’s Low-Income Subsidy program. Because the subsidy addresses the members’ prescription needs, our LIS plans can focus on providing more meaningful medical and supplemental benefits like dental, hearing, vision, fitness, and others to address the member’s overall health.


